George Bridgetower (1778-1860) performed extensively as a soloist, quartet member, and orchestral violinist in London, Dresden, and Vienna. His most well-documented concert was a collaboration with Beethoven, where audiences clamored for encores. The son of a West Indian father and European mother, Bridgetower was often marketed as the "son of an African Prince" in his early days as a prodigy.
