Sydney Lambert (1838-1905) was a Black American pianist, educator, and composer born as a free person of color to a musical family in New Orleans. He emigrated to France as a teenager and later worked as a pianist at the Portuguese court of King Dom Pedro. He was renowned for his compositional innovation in the 1870s and published 32 pieces between 1866 and 1899.
