Cecilia Maria Barthélemon (1767-1859) was an English composer, pianist, organist, and singer who performed for the King of Naples and Marie Antoinette as a young child on tour with her parents. Her compositions were published from 1786-1795 and include seven keyboard sonatas and a character piece. She was a friend of Haydn and dedicated her Op. 3 keyboard sonata to him in 1794.
