Julie Candeille (1767-1834) was a French singer, pianist, harpist, writer, actress, and composer whose most famous work was *Catherine*, ou *La belle fermière*, a comedy for which she wrote the libretto and music. In addition to writing songs and virtuosic solo keyboard music, she published essays, memoirs, and historical novels. Candeille advocated for women musicians and actively promoted their careers.
