
Trio, Op. 45: Allegro deciso

Louise Farrenc (1804–1875) was a French composer, pianist, and scholar who was the second woman to hold a permanent piano professorship at the Paris Conservatory. During her thirty-year tenure at the Conservatory, her etudes were part of the school's required curriculum. An advocate for reviving historical keyboard music, she hosted séances historiques in which she and her students performed older works.
